Barton House residents' update - Tuesday 2 January update

I would like to wish you all a happy new year.

We shared before the end of last year that we're working with our contractors to establish what further safety measures are needed at Barton House. In previous updates I shared the need to carry out further fireproofing works in some flats and legionella testing. I can also confirm we will be undertaking a third piece of work to install a communal fire alarm system at the block.

Initial work to begin installing this new alarm system will start tomorrow (Wednesday 3 January) and will be starting in the communal areas. We will be able to share further details about how the fire alarm system will work at the next residents' meeting, scheduled for Wednesday 10 January.

Housing Officer presence: We would like to thank you for your patience following the reduced service over the recent bank holiday weekend. From today, normal service will resume and staff will be available to provide support and information at the following times:

- Barton House: Housing Officers will be available from 9.30am until 12noon on weekdays
- Holiday Inn: Housing Officers will be available from 12.30pm until 5pm on weekdays

Housing Officers will not be available at Barton House or Holiday Inn over the weekend. If residents need help outside of these hours or can't get a hold of a member of staff at any time, please call 0800 694 0184. Housing Officers will be oncall and can be available quickly, if needed.

Meal times at the Holiday Inn: As children return to school following the Christmas break, lunchtime hours will change from Wednesday 3 January. The lunch service has now been split into two timeslots. This has been changed to keep the food warmer and to make sure that snacks are available for the children when they return from school. Breakfast and dinner timings will remain unchanged:

- Breakfast 7am until 10am
- Lunch 12.30pm until 2pm and again at 4pm until 5pm
- Dinner 6.30pm until 9pm
